Child sexual abuse is an epidemic.

1 in 10 children will be sexually abused by their 18th birthday.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recognizes child sexual abuse as a public health crisis.

There is a solution. Stewards of Children is a nationally distributed, evidence-based program proven to increase knowledge, improve attitudes, and change child protective behaviors.

Stewards of Children takes a comprehensive approach to educating adults and youth serving organizations to prevent, recognize, and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. It is designed for parents and for any organization that serves youth, including schools and education institutions, faith centers, sports leagues, and law enforcement.

The 2-hour training includes facilitator-led discussion, interactive workbook activity, and compelling video. Stewards of Children also helps organizations ensure the safest space possible for kids by providing the tools and information needed for any group to strengthen child protection policies and procedures.

Stewards of Children is a program that works. Multiple studies have shown that Stewards of Children is effective in increasing knowledge, improving attitudes and positively changing adults' child-protective behaviors over the long-term.

Stewards of Children goes beyond awareness, it provides skills. Participants learn specific concrete actions that they can take, as individuals and as a part of bigger organizations, that work to protect children.

- Youth are the victims in 66% of all sexual offenses reported to law enforcement
- Youth are 2.5 times more likely to be raped than adults
- 90% of children who are victims of sexual abuse know their abuser
- 80% or more of child sexual abuse incidents happen in isolated, one-on-one situations
